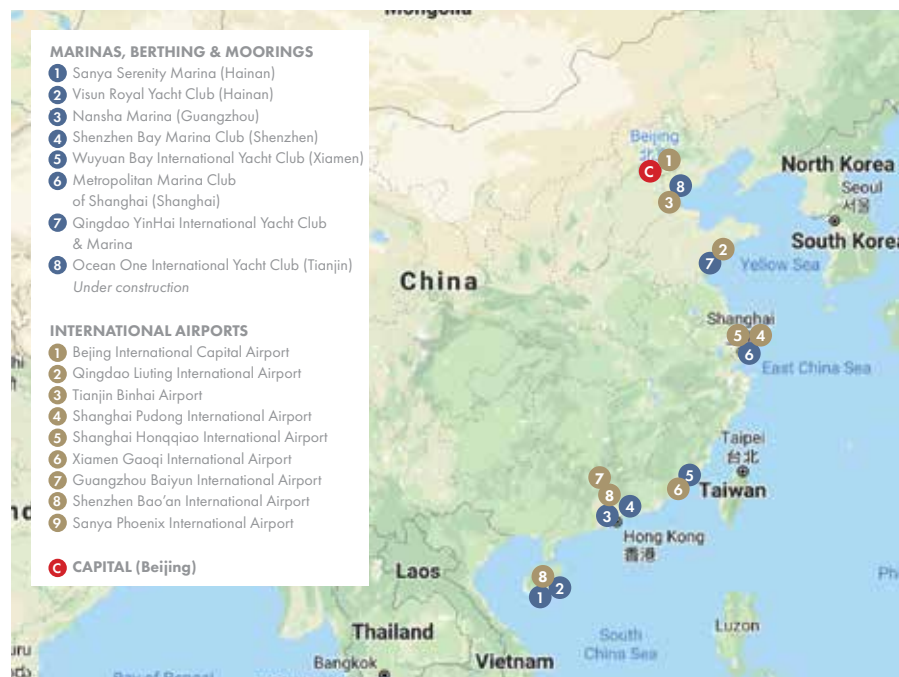

 China is very big. From the northernmost port, Jinzhou (40.89N), to the southern tip of Hainan (18.16N) is more than 2,200nm, and the climate goes from tropical to continental-cold. History dictates that for a long time there was no such thing as recreational boating in China, and in relation to the population the country is still resource-poor where yachting is concerned. China also lacks a coherent national policy with regard to private boats, meaning that regulations concerning entry differ from province to province and even from port to port. There are marina developments in China but not many that can accommodate superyachts and the administrative labyrinth is challenging to visiting yachts.

## HAINAN

Hainan is the smallest and southern most province of the People's Republic of China PRC). Hainan Island, is the largest and most populous island, which makes up 97% with the rest divided among over 200 islands scattered across three archipelagos. Considered the Hawaii of China, Hainan island enjoys a temperate climate all your round and is the only place in China to have tropical style beaches. Hainan's statue has recently changed and with the aim of it becoming China's biggest Free Trade Zone. The master-plan was released in June 2020, and boats, boaters, and the boating industry are on the agenda for future development. Haikou is the capital of the province, while Sanya is the most popular tourist destination in the south.

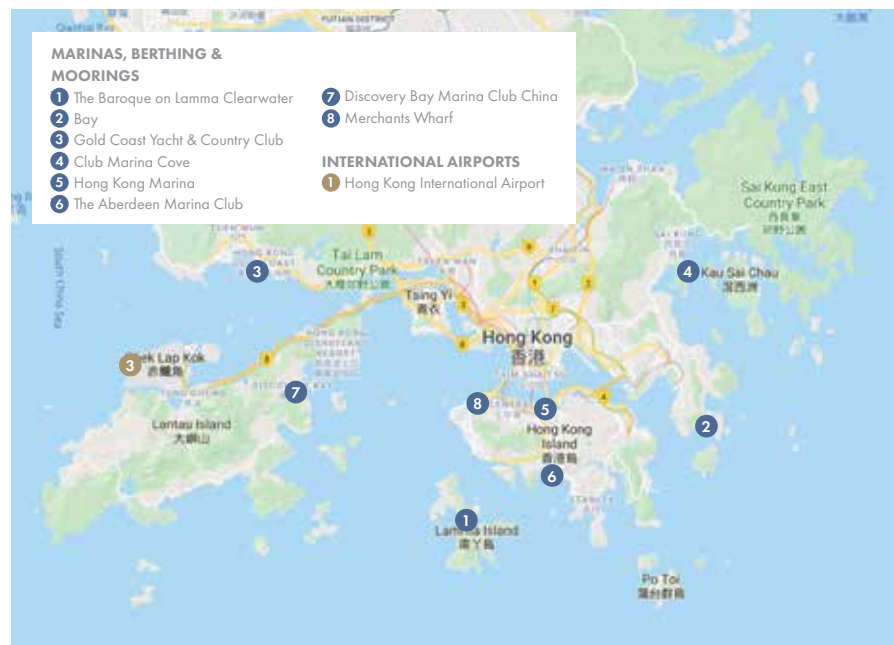

### Anchorage and Cruising:

In June 2019, the Hainan Provincial Government unveiled an Implementation Plan for "Free Cruising" for Yachts from Hong Kong and Macao in the China (Hainan) Pilot Free Trade Zone. Yachts from Hong Kong and Macao can enter eight scenic water areas with temporary approvals. They are Dongying, Boao, Shimei Bay, Haitang Bay, Sanya Nanshan Cultural Tourism Zone, Longmu Bay, Qizi Bay, and Lingao Cape. The policy also simplifies entry and exit approval procedures, and cancels requirements for single-voyage certification registration.

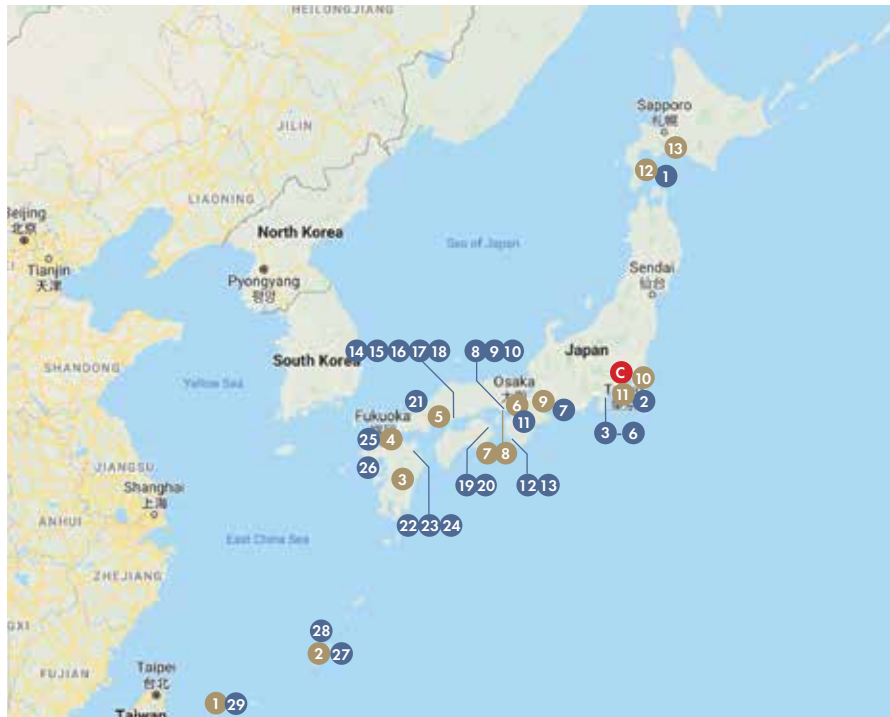

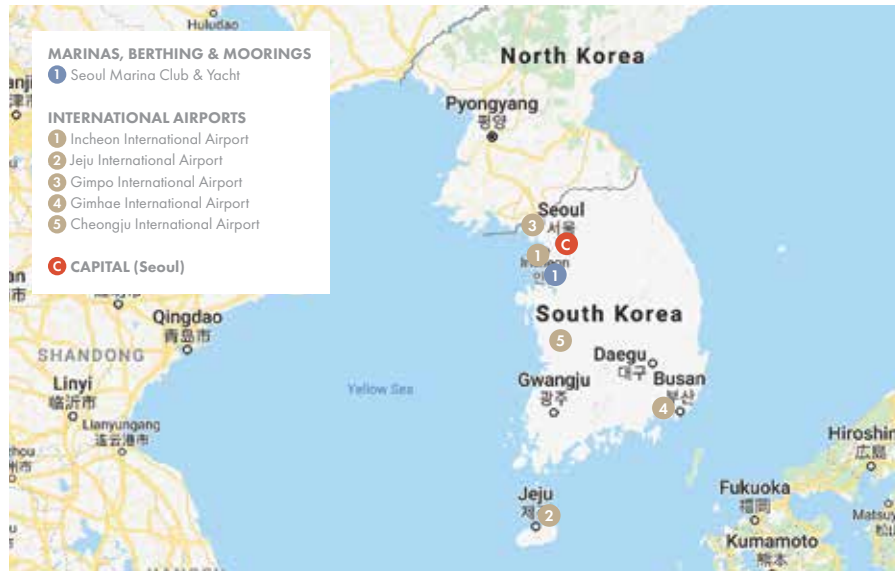

Korea is among the world's fastest-growing advanced economies and is a world leader in innovation and technologically advanced goods such as electronics, automobiles, ships, machinery, petrochemicals and robotics. The west coast of Korea has 10m tidal ranges and endless mudflats, while the east coast consists mostly of small commercial fishing ports. The south coast, from Busan to Mokpo, offers beautiful cruising among thousands of islands, but there are only a few marinas. The marina built in Busan for the Seoul Olympics can now be used by cruising yachts but has little in the way of facilities for superyachts. Picturesque Jeju Island is a major domestic holiday and honeymoon destination, but again not much marine infrastructure.

 Taiwan has been building quality superyachts for a long time, and ranks as the 5th largest builder in the world by total feet launched. The same shipyards provide first class refit and repair services. Taiwan has over 800nm of coastline, with the most spectacular facing the Pacific Ocean to the east. Apart from commercial fishing, the local population has been discouraged from engaging with the sea for political and military reasons, but the sentiment is beginning to change. Kaohsiung now has marinas that can accommodate superyachts, and the Penghu Islands in the Taiwan Strait are a pleasant cruising and sailing grounds with growing water sports and recreational facilities.
